

## Awards to Be Presented

### Divisions I

-A Division I trophy will be awarded to teams receiving a rating of 90-100 in one category.

The following is a breakdown of Division II, III, and IV.

80-89 Division II

70-79 Division III

60-69 Division IV

### Solo Awards

-Each Division I solo will be awarded a ribbon.

- Three places will be awarded medals for all age classification.

- Solos in the private category, will only compete with other private solos. Solos entered in the public category will only compete with public solos.

- A Cash Scholarship will be awarded to the Highest Scoring HS soloist (9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup>) regardless of private or public.

-Solo finalist will be announced in the main gym and will need to be dressed before awards. Time of announcement TBD.

-Only the winners in the high school division in both the private and public category perform their solos.

-Any soloist competing two solos can only place in the finals with their highest scoring solo.

### Duets and Small Ensembles

-Each Division I performance will be awarded ribbons for all participants.

-Within each category and age classification the top three places will be awarded medals for all participants.

- Duets in the private category, will only compete with other private duets. Duets entered in the public category will only compete with public duets.

### Medium and Large Ensembles

-Each Division I performance will be awarded ribbons for all participants

-Within each category and age classification the top three places will be awarded trophies.

- Ensembles in the private category, will only compete with other private ensembles. Ensembles entered in the public category will only compete with public ensembles.

### Grand Champion Team:

-You must enter three Team Routines to be eligible.

-There must be at least two teams registered in your category/division to be eligible for Grand Championship.

-Private, Middle school and High School Grand Champions will be awarded a cash prize.

### Officer Awards

-Within each category of the middle and high school officer group the top places will be awarded trophies.

-In the middle school and high classification; if entering 3+ officer routines, only the top scoring routines count towards the final average score for the Grand Champion Officer award.

-There must be at least two teams registered in your category/division to be eligible for the Officer Grand Championship.

### Team Awards

-Within each category and age classification the top three places will be awarded trophies.

-If a team is the only entry in a category they must score a 90 or above from each judge in order to receive 1<sup>st</sup> place.

-In the private, middle school and high school classification; if entering 3+ team routines, only the top 3 scoring routines count towards final average score for the Grand Champion award.

### Judges Awards

-All entries are eligible for the following:

Best Showmanship

Outstanding Choreography

Best Technique

### Audience Award

-Audience members will be given an opportunity to vote one time for their favorite routine.

The routine with the most votes will be awarded the VRDC Crowd Favorite.
